Sustainability, sustainable management, circular economy and sustainable production open access e-learning modules and materials – Intellectual Outputs of an Erasmus+ project TOO4TO

The consortium of the Erasmus+ Project “Sustainable Management: Tools for Tomorrow” ([TOO4TO](#)) has developed e-learning modules and materials that address various topics, including sustainability, sustainable management, circular economy, and sustainable production. The modules’ main objective is to improve learners’ knowledge of tools and techniques that can promote sustainable management in an organisational context. The e-learning modules and materials are based on recent data acquired and compiled in the [Dynamic Material Bank](#) and the framework provided in the [TOO4TO Training Curriculum](#).

The consortium piloted two of its created modules among its participating HEIs in 2022-2023: 1) Introduction to Sustainability and Sustainable Management, and 2) Circular Economy, Economics & Sustainability, Sustainable Production. These e-learning modules and materials offer complementary information on the topics, including crucial definitions and concepts and useful tools and techniques that can help assess and implement sustainable management and the circular economy in business operations.

Different target groups can use the materials offered in the e-learning modules, including students and teachers from educational institutions in the EU and beyond, decision-makers and public administration representatives, and business professionals from organisations of all sizes.

Other HEIs are welcome to use the modules’ presentation materials as a base to create their teaching materials for similar modules. Teachers/trainers can also request Moodle versions of the two modules that contain complementary learning materials such as infographics, quizzes and exercises.
